### I. 개요

- O This lesson plan is used in an **international context**. As such, this lesson plan does **not** cater to a class consisting of exclusively Korean students. This lesson is intended for a wide international audience of all students (regardless of race, ethnicity, gender, socio-economic status, etc.).
- O Also, as this lesson is intended for an international context it is highly advisable that this lesson be looked at within an international school context and not a Korean school context due to clear and notable differences between the two systems.
- O Also, while this lesson was made under the systematic theories of instruction design, it is advisable to the instructor that he or she use this lesson as a guideline and that it be altered to suit the teacher's individual teaching style as I, the designer, heavily believe that the best lesson is delivered according to the style and strengths of each teacher.
